Practice Schedule: Will alternate weeks with early and late practice between boys and girls—it will be listed on Monday on the calendar.

Early Practice—4 to 5:30

Late Practice—5:30-7

Away Games: Leave time from school will be announced. Please make sure to have a water bottle for your child. It is the parent's responsibility to find a ride for your child if you are not able to attend. Contact a coach if you need help with a ride.

Home Games: Be ready to go 30 minutes before game time. Meet in music room.

Game Schedule is subject to change---games may be added or changed. It will be communicated as soon as possible of any changes.

Uniforms: Uniforms will be handed out by the coaches shortly before our first game. Uniforms are expected to be washed and returned in good condition. Please wash and HANG DRY to help preserve the uniforms longer.

Dress Code Attire on Game Days: All players will be asked to wear khakis and their warm up.

Grades: As an athlete you are first and foremost a student! Grades are very important and you need to keep them up in order to play. Please be honest with us coaches and if you need to stay after school to do homework, do it! We will be following St. Paul Lutheran School's code of conduct in order to play.

Playtime: Playtime will be based on ability, attendance at practice, and work ethic/attitude at practice. Equal playing time is not a guarantee. Coaches are given the flexibility to evaluate athletes during practices on a weekly basis. Playing time is determined by the coach's discretion. Parents are not to "coach" their children during games and tournaments. The athletes should be focused on what their coaches have to say with respect to the team and their play. If you have questions about playing time or any coaching decision, please set up a time to discuss the situation with your Athletic Director and he/she will help answer your questions, and/or set up a meeting with the Coach. Parents should not approach, call, text, or email the AD until 24 hours after an activity has concluded. This gives you time to reflect and think of the best way to voice your concerns.

Concession/Admission/Clean-Up Duty Workers: As a parent of a student that participates on a St. Paul Lutheran Ministries Sports Club team you will be expected to work a shift(s) in either the concession/admission/clean-up duty on home game days. This includes the LCMS Church families that participate. Depending on the season, volunteers will be asked or parents may be assigned to work. If assigned, parents will be notified of their assigned work shift in advance.
