Basketball

- **Practice Schedule – M, T, Th, F Boys: 3:30-5:15pm Girls: 5:30-7:00pm**
- Practice will begin on Monday, November 30th (after Thanksgiving Break)
 - Practices times will ultimately be up to coach’s discretion (may be subject to change)
 - Efforts will be made to work around other team practice schedule

Concessions/Admissions/Clean-Up

- Need to find a replacement if you are not able to work your shift
- PPP hours may be counted – You need to sign the binder, for you hours to count.
- No students working in the Concession stand this season, due to COVID precautions.

Away Games

- Leave time from school will be announced, via Beacon Text
- Game Locations/Directions
 - All schools locations are posted on our website www.stpaulwp.org (please note that some games are played at a different location other than the school)

- **Pack a Snack**, this year it's hard to say if there will be concessions available
 - Most schools used to have concession stands
 - It is still a good idea to send money, as drivers may go through a drive through on the way home.
- **Please send a Water Bottle**, or Gatorade, etc. for your child
- It is the parent's responsibility to find a ride for your child if you are not able to attend
 - Please notify the coach or the school if your child needs a ride, we can help you out.

Home Games

- School policy states that all students must be supervised while at SPLS. Students not supervised after 3:45 p.m. by either a coach, teacher, or parent will be required to check into our Kingdom Kids After School Club and parents will be charged accordingly for this service.
 - Announcements will be made using the Beacon if a coach is able to supervise students after school until game time.
- As a rule of thumb coaches would like their players to arrive:
 - 30 minutes prior to game time (basketball) this may be difficult in COVID

Uniforms

- Will be handed out by the coach
- Uniforms are expected to be washed and returned in good condition
- On game days both boys and girls are asked to pack both the white and blue jerseys
- Warm-up shirts
 - School has warm-up shirts on hand to lend out for both boys & girls

Grades

- Please refer to the St. Paul Lutheran Ministries Sports Club Handbook
 - Must maintain a "C" Average in all core subjects, a grade lower than a "C-" average does not make a child ineligible unless the overall average is below a "C-"
- Mrs. Brockmann will notify coaches of student ineligibility

Covid Preventative Measures -

These are within the current DHMs, This plan is subject to change.

Practice:

- Temperature checks
- Sanitizer before practice
- Water bottles for practice (No fountain access)
- Wipe down Basketballs after practice
- Sanitize benches
- **Enter front doors** (east doors) of school
- **Exit gym doors** (south doors) of school
- No parents at practices – this is to limit people in buildings

Games:

- Temperature checks
- Sanitizer available at entrance and encouraged
- **MASKS**
All Spectators must wear a mask at all times (NSAA RULE)
Coaches will wear masks/face shields at all times (NSAA RULE)
Players must wear masks entering & seated on bench, optional when playing (NSAA RULE)
- Separate seating for Home team and Visiting Team
- Seating Limited to 25% Capacity, only household member can attend (NEBRASKA DHM)
Two parent/guardian (same household) can attend the game per player (excludes coaches)
- **Water Bottles** -bring your own (No fountain access)
- Sanitize benches before and after games
- Team Basketballs must be wiped down after use
- Schedules are subject to change, to ensure the health and safety of our students and staff
- **Enter front doors (east doors) of school**
- **Exit gym doors (south doors) of school**
- No Locker rooms for Away teams
- **Coaches, Players, Spectators – for 2nd Game – will need to wait outside** (not in our gym or school) for the first game to be completed, before entering to ensure we do not go over the 25% capacity.
