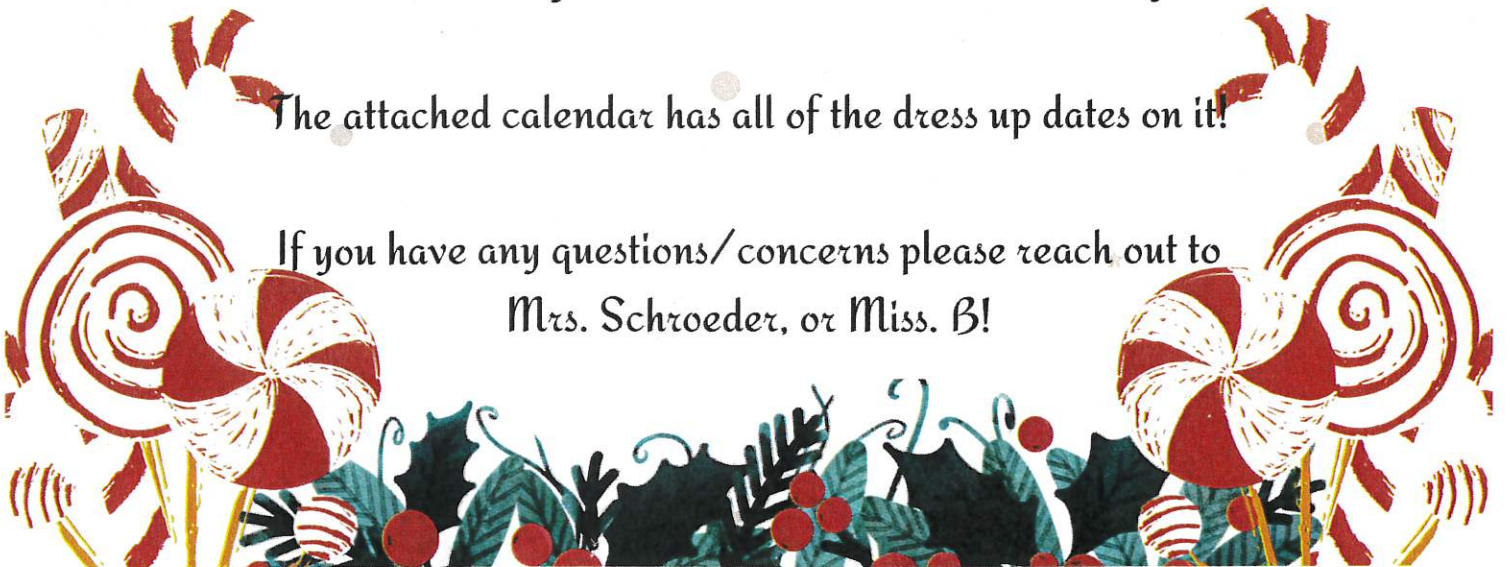
It was the few weeks before Christmas Break, and all through the school everyone was scurrying to brighten spirits and have a little fun, even the mice;)

The Cookie Walk will be on Sunday, December 10th, 2023, from 3:00-4:00 pm.

The Annual Cookie Walk is a fundraiser and will immediately follow the St. Paul Lutheran Ministries Christmas Program, also held at the Nielsen Community Center at 2:00 pm.

How does it Work?

Each school and Sunday school family brings five (5) dozen of your favorite Christmas treat. These can be cookies, candies, bars, puppy chow, or anything else you love to have at Christmas. Please be generous with your baking. Make it a family event by asking grandparents or friends to help you bake.

Tables will hold all of your tempting treats. After the performance, people will pick up containers, walk from table to table, and fill their container(s) with yummy treats. The container(s) are then weighed, as guests pay by the pound.

Please send your treats in sealed containers to keep them fresh. They should be ready to be set out and displayed at the Cookie Walk.

Please deliver your treats either on Friday, December 8th, at the school (during school hours) or directly to the Nielsen Community Center on Sunday morning, December 10th beginning at 12:30 pm.

The Cookie Walk is open to everyone, even if they are not attending the program. The proceeds will go towards St. Paul Lutheran Ministries.

Again, we ask that you are generous with your baking. Our Cookie Walk is to help many families and friends fill their freezers with Holiday Treats.
