Dear St. Paul Lutheran School Families:

As you may remember, during the second semester of last school year, we applied for and were blessed to receive a significant Supply Chain Assistance Grant from the state. This grant allowed us to cover the cost of each of the students' milk at snack beginning as of April 12, 2022. It also allowed us to cover milk at snack for the entire 2022-2023 school year with no charges being passed along to the students.

We have recently been blessed to receive a second amount, with the possibility of a third amount, of funds associated with the same Supply Chain Assistance Grant. We are very limited in how this grant allows us to use the funds. It must be used for non-processed or minimally processed food items only.

What this means for St. Paul Student's is the following: students who currently receive free lunches and students who receive reduced lunches, at \$0.40 each, will continue to do so with no changes. Milk will continue to be free at snack time. Students purchasing seconds at GACC will see no changes.

The biggest change that we are able to make is that as of January 4th, 2023, and for the remainder of the 2022-2023 school year, our lunch prices for each student will decrease as follows:

Grade	Current Price	Price as of January 4, 2023
Kindergarten	\$3.65	\$1.83
Grades 1-6	\$3.75	\$1.88
Grades 7 & 8	\$3.95	\$1.98

The amount of funds that we have received will allow us to continue doing this for at least the remainder of the school year, or until the full amount of the grant money has been depleted. When that grant money is depleted, we will resume charging each student for milk at snacks as well as full prices for lunch. However, before this occurs, we will notify you well in advance.
